## Wines by the bottle

### Champagne

- 1 Delamotte Brut NV** £80.00  
Delamotte is a real insider's Champagne, though it is one of the very best in the region. Quite rich, bold and toasty, although still refined. Lovely warm toast and vanilla notes on the palate which is rounded and delicious.
- 4 Delamotte Blanc de Blancs NV** £95.00  
One of the oldest established Champagne houses, sister house to the exclusive Salon. Made with 100% Chardonnay from the Côte des Blancs. It is elegant and fresh, poised, perfumed and bright. It goes beautifully with or without food.
- 12 Delamotte Rosé Brut NV** £98.00  
Finesse and elegance are synonymous with Delamotte, one of Champagne's most respected names. Still made following the rare and traditional saignée method, Delamotte rosé stands out for its structural delicacy and appealing wild strawberry fruit.
- 6 Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rosé Brut NV** £120.00  
Unlike most rosé champagne the basis of Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut is obtained by drawing the juice from black grapes in the vat, not only by blending red and white wines. It is cellared for at least four years, a super rosé Champagne.

### Sparkling Wine

- 10 Prosecco Colli Trevigiani Brut Sylvoz Le Colture NV Italy** £32.00  
Super value prosecco unlike any supermarket offering you may have tried. This is a highly regarded family estate who have been making wine since the 1500's.
- 11 Ambriel Classic Cuvee Brut Traditional Method NV** £70.00  
This is an elegant English sparkling wine, bright and fine, with ripe cox apple and pear flavours, creamy summer berries and notes of brioche. Small in scale, the boutique winery Ambriel based in West Sussex sets the quality bar high.

## Whites by the bottle

### Chardonnay

- 18 Santa Florentina Chardonnay, Argentina** £30.00  
No oak is used in this style of Chardonnay. Aromas of green apple, with some honeysuckle notes particularly characteristic of this high-altitude valley. The palate is light to medium-bodied, offering fresh apple/citrus flavours and good balancing acidity.
- 19 Les Grenadiers Chardonnay IGP Cotes de Thongue, Languedoc** £32.00  
Vignerons Alignan du Vent-Neffiès is a dynamic cooperative producing high quality wines with an international style from the Languedoc region of France. Easy drinking, ripe and round with creamy, peach fruit and spicy vanilla notes.
- 13 Block 1A Chardonnay The Lane, Adelaide Australia** £42.00  
Delightfully concentrated citrus and honeyed fruit, well integrated oak and a long satisfying finish.
- 22 Chardonnay Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa** £45.00  
As a registered estate, Nelson's Creek only produces wine from grapes that are grown on the estate. Their philosophy is to spare no expense and take a hands-on approach to tending the vineyards. Individual berry selection of grapes ensures premium quality from this medal winning wine maker.

<b>21 Macon Verze “Allure” Domaine de la Jobeline, Burgundy</b>	<b>£48.00</b>
A Decanter Gold Medal 2020 winner, this wine comes from a new property of the prestigious Domaine Leflaive. It is a great way to taste one of the most important producers in the world at a great price point.	
<b>15 Petit Chablis Domaine Louis Moreau</b>	<b>£52.00</b>
Fresh and aromatic with apple and citrus on the nose, followed by a well-rounded finish.	
<b>26 St Aubin 1er Cru Dents De Chien Olivier Leflaive, France.</b>	<b>£61.00</b>
Fine gold. Light toasted spicy oak aroma. Smoothly ripe and full to taste. Long and full in the finish.	
<b>27 Chardonnay Bakestone Cellars, Napa, California</b>	<b>£65.00</b>
From legendary Californian producer Cakebread, comes their second label, Bakestone Cellars. Offering the trademark freshness, concentration and complexity from select premier vineyards around Northern California	
<b>23 Pouilly-Fuisse Moulin du Pont Maison Auvigue, France</b>	<b>£70.00</b>
Made in the purest of the appellations’ traditions, a hazelnut and almond bouquet, ample and vigorous in the mouth, as it should be!	
<b>20 Cakebread Chardonnay, Napa Valley U.S.A</b>	<b>£78.00</b>
Over 30 years ago, Jack Cakebread came to photograph the Napa Valley for a book and ended up buying a vineyard. Rich, fresh and creamy on the palate, with beautiful underlying structure.	
<b>24 Puligny-Montrachet Les Combettes 1er Cfru Domaine Jacques Prieur, Burgundy</b>	<b>£140.00</b>
Edouard Labruyère walks the talk. Meticulous in his approach, both in the vineyard and in the pristine cellars. This is a characteristic style, rounded, luscious and rather hedonistic in style, though with a classical tension and focus. It is a splendid wine.	
<b>Sauvignon Blanc</b>	
<b>28 Panul Sauvignon Blanc, Chile</b>	<b>£30.00</b>
Fresh, grassy with gooseberry fruits and a great long finish. A delicious glass of wine from one of the up-and-coming appellations in the Colchagua Valley.	
<b>29 Eradus Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>	<b>£49.00</b>
A lovely vegetal and asparagus style of Sauvignon Blanc. This wine is delicious, rich & leafy fresh – fantastic. Winners of 17 gold medals no less!	
<b>30 Sauvignon Blanc Quincy Une Promesse Domaine de l’Epine, Loire</b>	<b>£49.00</b>
A stylish, subtle Sauvignon Blanc from rising star Elodie Vilpellet and her tiny estate Domaine de l’Epine. This 2019 vintage won a coveted Liger d’Argent medal in the Loire Valley’s annual wine competition at Anger.	
<b>32 Pouilly Fume Loire, France</b>	<b>£63.00</b>
Classical flinty steel Sauvignon Blanc. Gunpowder and smoke aroma with a lingering finish	
<b>Riesling</b>	
<b>36 Homer Riesling Marlborough, New Zealand</b>	<b>£39.50</b>
Single vineyard varietal. Zingy and fresh with a citrus bouquet and finish—Ideal partner for most white meat and fish	
<b>37 Rheingau Riesling Kabinett Schloss Schonborn, Germany</b>	<b>£49.00</b>
A lovely wine from an award-winning estate that has been established for over 650 years. Good with asparagus and hollandaise sauce or with fresh fish.	

## Pinot Grigio & Gris

### 42 Pinot Grigio Luna Cecilia Beretta, Italy £32.00

Northern Italy's most fashionable wine! Grilled almonds with gooseberries, citrus fruits and a subtle underlying minerality.

### 43 Pinot Grigio Sanziana, Romania £32.00

Premium wine estate Recas Bramele was founded in 1998 with vineyards that are said to be some of the oldest in the world. The emphasis here is on quality and innovation achieved by passion and hard work.

## The Remaining Whites

### 48 Il Carretto IGT Bianco di Puglia, Italy £30.00

Malvasia grapes, from the sunny and warm Puglia region in Italy. This grape variety needs lots of sun and warmth so it is at its best here. Its zesty aromas and almondy notes make it a very versatile wine.

### 47 Picpoul de Pinet Domaine Morin Langaran, Languedoc-Roussillon £32.00

Winemakers in the Picpoul de Pinet appellation in Languedoc create their own exceptional white wine using one of the region's oldest white grapes, Picpoul. Known for being fresh, lively and citrus focused, this example from Domaine Morin-Langaran is exceptional. Organic certified, it is full of juicy lemon fruit and mineral freshness.

### 52 Soave Terre di Brognoligo Cecilia Beretta, Italy £35.00

A stunning wine showing what yardstick Soave is all about-ripe, warm, semi tropical fruit, bone dry and truly satisfying.

### 49 Gewurztraminer Cléebourg, Alsace France £35.00

Located 60 kilometres north of Strasbourg, Cave de Cléebourg's vineyards are in the Northern Vosges Mountains. Lychee and cinnamon fruit with an amazing concentration on the nose and palate.

### 58 Rioja Blanco Belezos Bodegas Zugober £35.00

White Rioja produced from 100% Viura grapes offering tropical fruit with a subtle cinnamon spice co. The fruity palate has a creamy long finish. The wine spends a minimum of 11 months in French oak barrels. A further 6 months of bottle ageing follows, before release.

### 57 Pazo la Maza Albarino Adegas Galegas DO Rias Baixas £39.00

A lively and refreshing Albariño made in its indigenous region -DO Rias Baixas- to accompany a large array of seafood and shell fish dishes.

### 55 Beaujolais Blanc Roche Noire Domaine Lathuilière Gravallon, Beaujolais £49.00

Domaine Lathuilière Gravallon is a small, family run domaine now in its 5<sup>th</sup> generation. Cathy and Cedric aim to strike a balance between the old and the new. Famed for its reds, Beaujolais also makes delicious Chardonnay. This wine is creamy in texture with ripe apple and peach characters and laced with minerals.

## Rosé

### 59 La Brouette Rosé, Vin de Pays du Comte Tolosan, France £30.00

Red fresh fruit nose with hints of wild strawberry and fruit drop. Very good with pork, shell fish or on its own.

### 60 Chateau la Tour de l'Eveque Rose AOC Cotes de Provence, Organic £39.95

A classic style of Provence rosé with vivacious red berry fruit, ripe nectarine and hints of sweet grapefruit. Its silky texture, delicate creaminess and vivid fruit make this delicious on its own or a wonderful match for a variety of food.

## Reds by the bottle

### Merlot and Merlot Blends

**62 Panul Merlot, Chile,** £30.00  
Soft rounded fruits and balanced tannins. Very drinkable.

**69 Soraie IGT Veneto Cecilia Beretta, Veneto Italy** £35.00  
Merlot with a twist! An innovative, affordable take on the classic Amarone style. Rich and velvety with black plum and cherry flavours and a chocolatey finish laced with vanilla.

**65 L'Hospitalet de Gazin, Pomerol. 2014** £75.00  
An immediate neighbour of the fabled Petrus – provenance therefor assured. The soil is clay-gravel, a happy home to 90% merlot, 7% cab sauvignon and 3 % cab franc – with average vine age at 35 years. This property was a domain of the Knights Hospitaliers of St Jean, Rhodes and Malta. This wine is packed with red and black fruits, bold and rich and is sure to impress wine-lovers anywhere.

### Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Blends

**71 Dom de Saissac, Cabernet Sauvignon, France** £30.00  
This wine has delicious berry fruits and a slight touch of oak. It offers claret style drinking with a softer, sunnier edge.

**76 Chateau Saint-Aubin, Medoc, Bordeaux** £49.00  
Classic cru bourgeois, a Cabernet Sauvignon lead wine with Merlot and Petit Vardot. The chateau is built on a magnificent site overlooking the Gironde estuary, about 70 kilometres north of Bordeaux.

**79 Nelson Estate Cabernet Merlot, South Africa** £55.00  
Nelson's Estate is a small, family-owned vineyard situated in the Paarl region of South Africa. Wine maker Lisha Nelson, ensures that the utmost care goes into producing every bottle.

**70 Chateau Dutruch Grand Poujeaux 2012 Moulis-en-Médoc, France** £59.00  
Good expression of supple fruit, quite open and easy-going, with nice freshness.

**75 The Lane "19th Meeting" Cabernet Sauvignon 2012, Australia** £75.00  
Assisted by his son Marty, John Edwards produces wines with real finesse, European in style but with an Aussie twist. Fine length and good tannins, a real occasion wine.

### Malbec

**82 Malbec Chamuyo, Mendoza, Argentina,** £35.00  
Situating winery in Mendoza in the foothills of the Andes this lovely malbec shows intense aromas of ripe red summer fruit, herbs and subtle warm pepper.

**84 Malbec Marchiori & Barraud, Perdriel, Mendoza, Argentina** £39.00  
Well-rounded with deep ruby colour, intense fruit flavours of blackberry, plum and spice and smooth tannins.

## Shiraz and Shiraz Blends

**90 Puertas Antiguas Shiraz** £27.00  
This fruity Shiraz has been blended specially for Corney & Barrow by Luis Felipe Edwards, one of Chile's leading family-owned wineries. Made from a special selection of the producer's best sites in the Valle Central, this wine offers the right amount of fruit, spice and tannins.

**87 Double Trouble Shiraz-Cabernet, Barossa Valley, Australia** £52.00  
This is made with old vine 35-40-year-old fruit, in the Barossa Valley. It is picked ripe and nestles in the best French oak for 18 months. Dense and creamy with a heart of black fruits, liquorice and Belgium chocolate, with plenty of savoury notes adding to the long, dry finish.

## Tempranillo

**96 Mas Oliver Tempranillo Campranillo, Spain** £29.90  
Soft oak and toffee flavours are revealed after an initial spicy draft.  
Great value alternative to Rioja

**98 Bodaga, Altos Baroja Rioja, Joven, Spain** £32.95  
Juicy and ripe on the palate with liquorice and savoury notes. A beautiful, well-made wine

**95 Belezos Rioja Crianza Bodegas Zugober, Alavesas, Spain** £35.00  
Powerful in the mouth, slightly spicy with hints of ripe fruit and structured with balanced tannins.  
Classic Rioja.

**97 Belezos Rioja Gran Reserva Bodegas Zugober 2010 Spain** £69.00  
Black fruits married with a wonderfully integrated oak all that you would expect from Grand Reserva.

## Pinot Noir

**101 Sanziana Pinot Noir Recas Cramele Romania** £29.95  
Bursting with summer berry fruit and a flash of Christmas spices. Another smash from Romania's award-winning winery Recas Cramele.

**102 Pinot Noir Eradus, Marlborough, New Zealand** £58.00  
The Eradus family winemaking philosophy centres on achieving wines with ripeness, balance and freshness. This Pinot Noir blends earthy mushroom notes with dark, perfumed fruit and flowers

**103 Pfalz Spatburgunder Trocken Weingut A Christmann** £60.00  
German Pinot Noir from one of the best producers of this style, declassified vineyard site means you get so much more for your money. Old organic vines just add to the quality.

**107 Gevrey-Chambertin Monopole Domaine Varoilles, Burgundy** £120.00  
Domaine des Varoilles combines a number of spectacular vineyards from village to grand cru level. The arrival of Gilbert Hammel in 1990 marked a turning point for the domaine. This, the highest of the domaine's vineyards comprises one hectare of vines with an average age of over 60 years. The palate is sweetly fruited with a broad, supple entry, fleshy and giving on the mid palette coming to a nice grippy point on the finish.

## Beaujolais

**119 Moulin-a-Vent Coeur de Terroirs Vieilles Vignes Domaine Labruyere, Beaujolais** £58.00  
Domaine Labruyère is Moulin-a-Vent's oldest estate, founded in 1850. It produces stunning, age-worthy wines which not only represent a pinnacle of what is happening in the region, but also offer some of the best value in the world of fine wine.

## The Remaining Reds

**121 Il Carretto IGT Rosso di Puglia, Italy** £29.95  
Bursting with ripe cherry fruit and laced with aromatic herbs, Il Carretto comes from a small vineyard in the heart of Puglia.

**114 Cabernet Franc-Tunella, Italy** £32.00  
Punchy varietal laced with rich blackcurrant fruit and cedarwood aroma—ideal with lamb and beef

**115 Primitivo Muchetta Puglia, Italy** £48.00  
Intensive and dry but with a depth of blackberry fruit for balance—perfect for game dishes

**113 Barbera d'Alba Giulia Negri, Piedmont, Italy** £48.00  
Using 100% Barbera, Fruit is harvested from a North West facing ridge. Dark red, strong, with persistent wild aromas. Full-bodied and richly fruity it is sustained by a refreshing and noteworthy acidity.

## Dessert Wines

**122 Château Septy Halves, Monbazillac, France** £6.50 50ml  
A super alternative to some of the pricier offerings in Bordeaux a good partner with lemon tart or any dairy based pudding. The nose has notes of honey and ripe fruits, the palate is delicate with a long finish.

**123 Pedro Ximenez San Emillio Solera Reserva Emilio Lustau, Spain** £7.50 50ml  
Very sweet, smooth, pronounced and delicious, just like dried raisins or sweet grape juice. Awarded Gold Medal at the IWC. Very good drizzled over ice cream!

**124 Tokaji Blue Label 5 Puttonyos Royal Tokaji Company.** £8.00 50ml  
Rumoured to be the world's first 'noble rot' sweet wine and made in tiny quantities, this Tokaji is a dessert wine for any special occasion. Sweet, rich and beautifully balanced, with citrus fruit and fine acidity giving a long, refreshing finish

## Port and fortified wines

**125 Corney & Barrow 20 year-old Tawny Port, Portugal** £8.00 50ml  
Good aged tawnies do not come cheap but this is fantastic for the price. With layers of figs, walnuts, cloves and candied citrus peel, it has compelling complexity and a refreshingly clean finish.
